



Legends of the Faith – Part 2: Joshua

It's important that God's Word continues after the message. At Celebrate, we find that you will quite often talk over this week's message long after our experience is over. That's because God has impact. The Sermon Discussion Guide is designed to help you continue the conversation all week.

God wants more for us, but we must take possession of what He wants to give us. (*Joshua 1:11, Jeremiah 29:11*) There are three key steps to take possession of our futures:

- 1. MAKE A PLAN.** Discuss the correlation between planning and success. As we look to the future we must learn from the past. However, we cannot possess the future if we perpetuate the past. What from your past do you need to let go (to bury) so you can move forward?
Joshua 1:2-3; Proverbs 20:18; Proverbs 13:16
- 2. STAY IN THE WORD.** Success is not based on ability, it is based on commitment. Not only are we to read God's Word; we are to talk about it, think about it and live it out. Discuss ways to incorporate this into your life. *Joshua 1:7-8; 2 Timothy 3:16*
- 3. STEP OUT- TAKE ACTION.** Faith is something you do, not what you believe. The first step is always the hardest. Just remember, courage is not the absence of fear, it is pushing through it. What is God calling you to do? How will you step out in faith and take action?
Joshua 1:9; Romans 8:3; Philippians 4:13
