### **Guest Speakers: The Crevier Family**

This week, we were joined by special guests from the Crevier family, whose basketball handling performances have given them a platform to share the light of Christ with many people.

God has created each of us in His image, with unique talents, interests, and other qualities that are designed to bring Him glory. Share about a time when God used something that is unique about you to accomplish His will. How have you seen God's glory uniquely manifested in other people in your life and life group?

Caleb Crevier shared a powerful story about when he was 19 years old and his aunt, Tonya, put him on the spot to share the Gospel with a group of high school students. He was nervous, and had a fear of public speaking due to a speech impediment. But Caleb chose to be faithful, and allowed himself to be stretched beyond what he is capable of accomplishing on his own. As a result of his sharing the Gospel, 23 young lives surrendered their lives to Christ that day! In what ways is God stretching you beyond what you are capable of today? How does God want us to respond to being stretched? Why does He stretch us beyond our capabilities?

*Luke 16:10; Matthew 25:23; James 1:2-4*

Tonya advised us to never choose the easy path. Consistent hard work has given her the incredible skills she has, and the Word of God has been a light to her path that's helped her to overcome obstacles and share Christ with thousands of people. What practical, small habits can you work into your daily life in order to grow into that which God has purposed for you? How are you choosing the "easy path", and what do you have to gain by embracing the harder, more meaningful path?
