



It's important that God's Word continues after the message. At Celebrate, we find that you will quite often talk over this week's message long after our experience is over. That's because God has impact. The Sermon Discussion Guide is designed to help you continue the conversation all week.

L.I.V.E.

The Bible talks about two lives that we have: the life we lived before Christ, versus the life we are called to live in Christ! If we are not careful, time will slip away and we will have lived a life in Christ without accomplishing much for Him. As Christians, we Live In View of Eternity.

1. Pay Attention

We are to live in such a way that our conduct around those who do not yet know Jesus will draw them to Jesus! To be able to live this kind of life, it takes living intentionally, to pay careful attention to everything we do and everything we say. If a video was recorded of our life over the past week, would someone come to know Jesus by watching it?

- a. **Pray** – Describe your prayer life. What is one area in your life where you would appreciate prayer? Ask the group to partner with you in this.
- b. **Plan** – Think of your past pain, joys and experiences. How have they shaped you to share the story of God's love through your life to others?
- c. **Prepare** – Are you in a LIFE group? If so, are you committed to attending regularly? Do you spend private time reading from the Bible? How are you giving back to God with your finances?

2. Pay the Price

We are Christ's ambassadors called to live our lives in such a way that it reflects the way Jesus lived. Pastor Reed mentioned that there are things he won't do, look at or put in his body for this reason. How can you personally relate to this discipline?
