Week 2 LIFE Group Discussion Guide

Brief Check-in

Does everyone know one another? If not, introduce anyone new. Check in briefly for about a minute with updates on accountability partners.

Memory Verse

“Be very careful, then, how you live—not as unwise but as wise, making the most of every opportunity, because the days are evil. Therefore, do not be foolish, but understand what the Lord’s will is” (Ephesians 5:15-17).

Video Questions

If you haven’t seen it already, play the Week 2 introductory video available at www.celebrate.church/unshakeable and begin your discussion by responding to it in your group.

What do those around you ‘read’ from your character qualities?

Which of the four qualities Pastor Keith mentioned (identity, discipline, courage, and humility) do you need to work on the most?

Discussion Questions

Identify someone you think represents Jesus well and describe why they are set apart in this way.

What are you passionate about or really good at? How is God already working through your passion and strengths, or what could it look like if He would?

How could this LIFE Group combine your passions and strengths to serve together this month?
